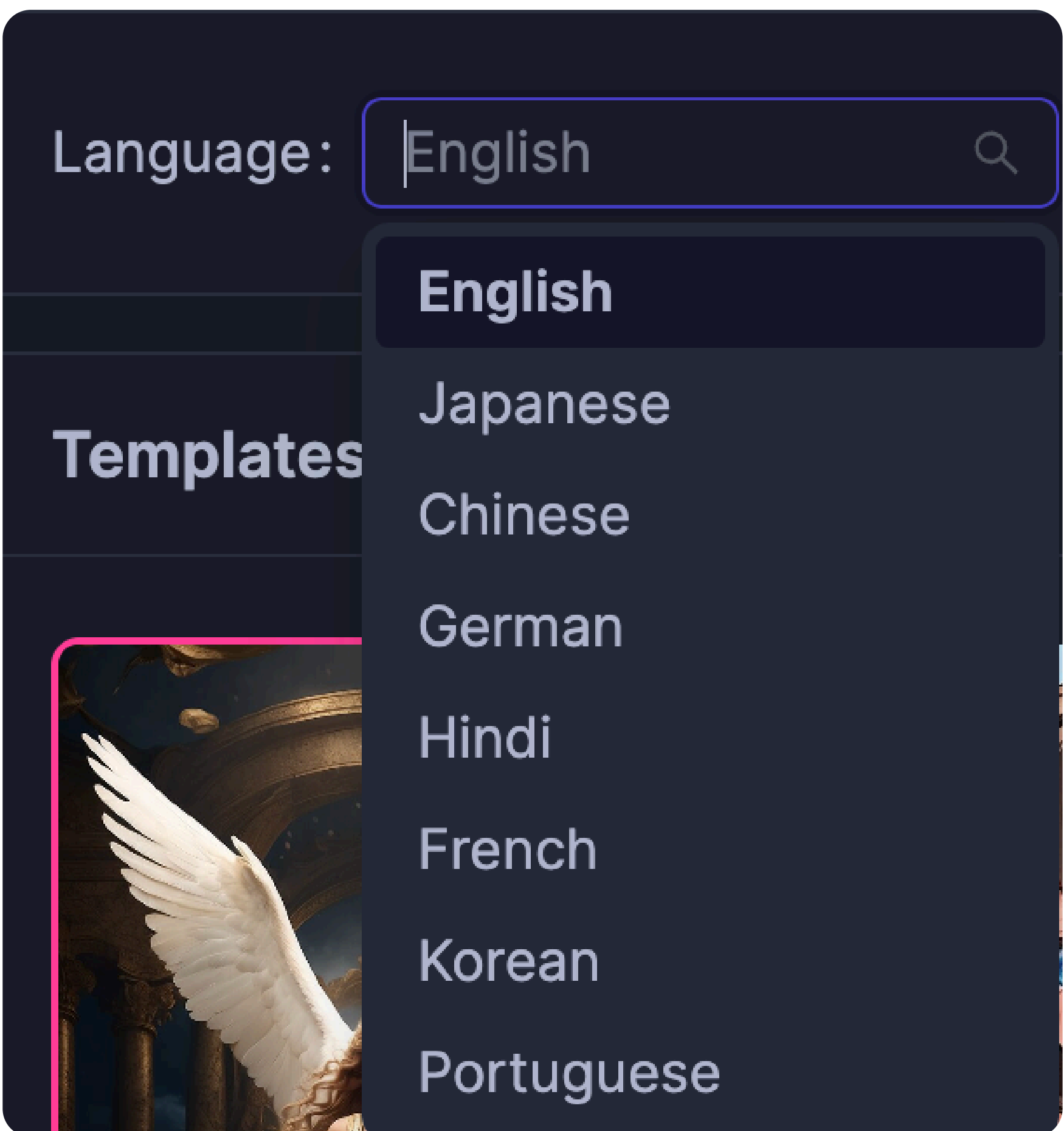

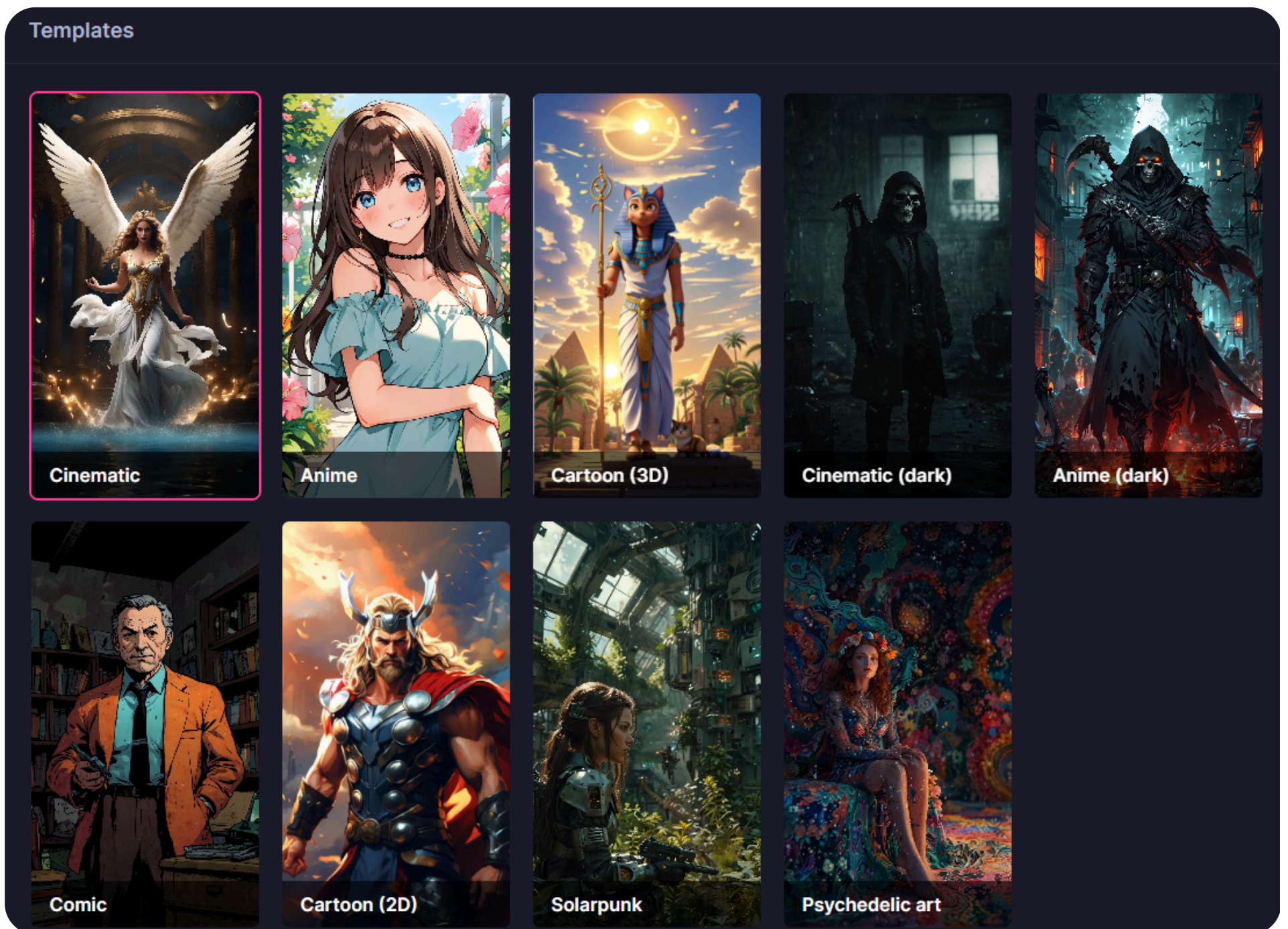

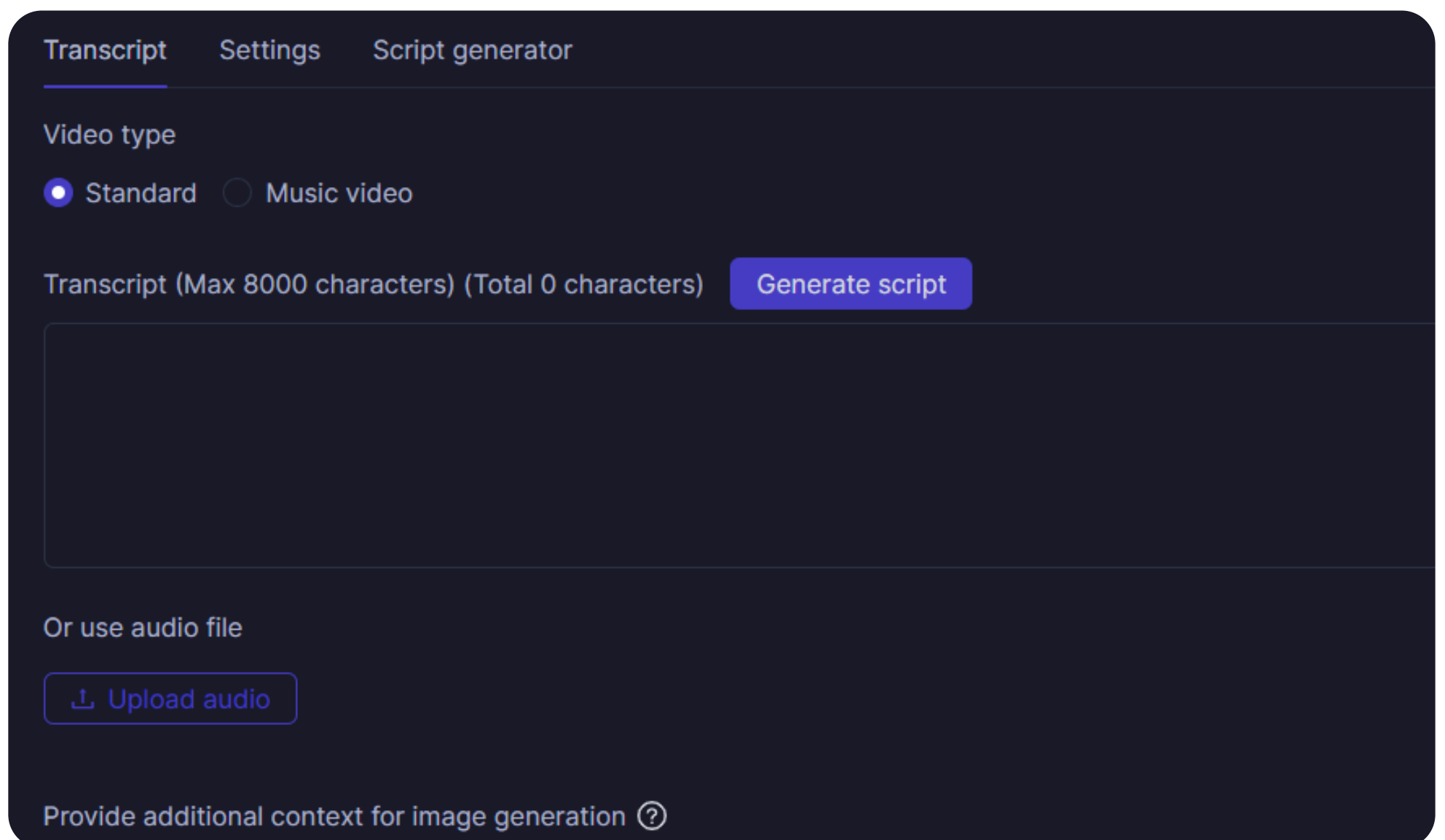

There are three tabs: **Transcript**, **Settings**, and **Script Generator**. We will discuss each of them further.



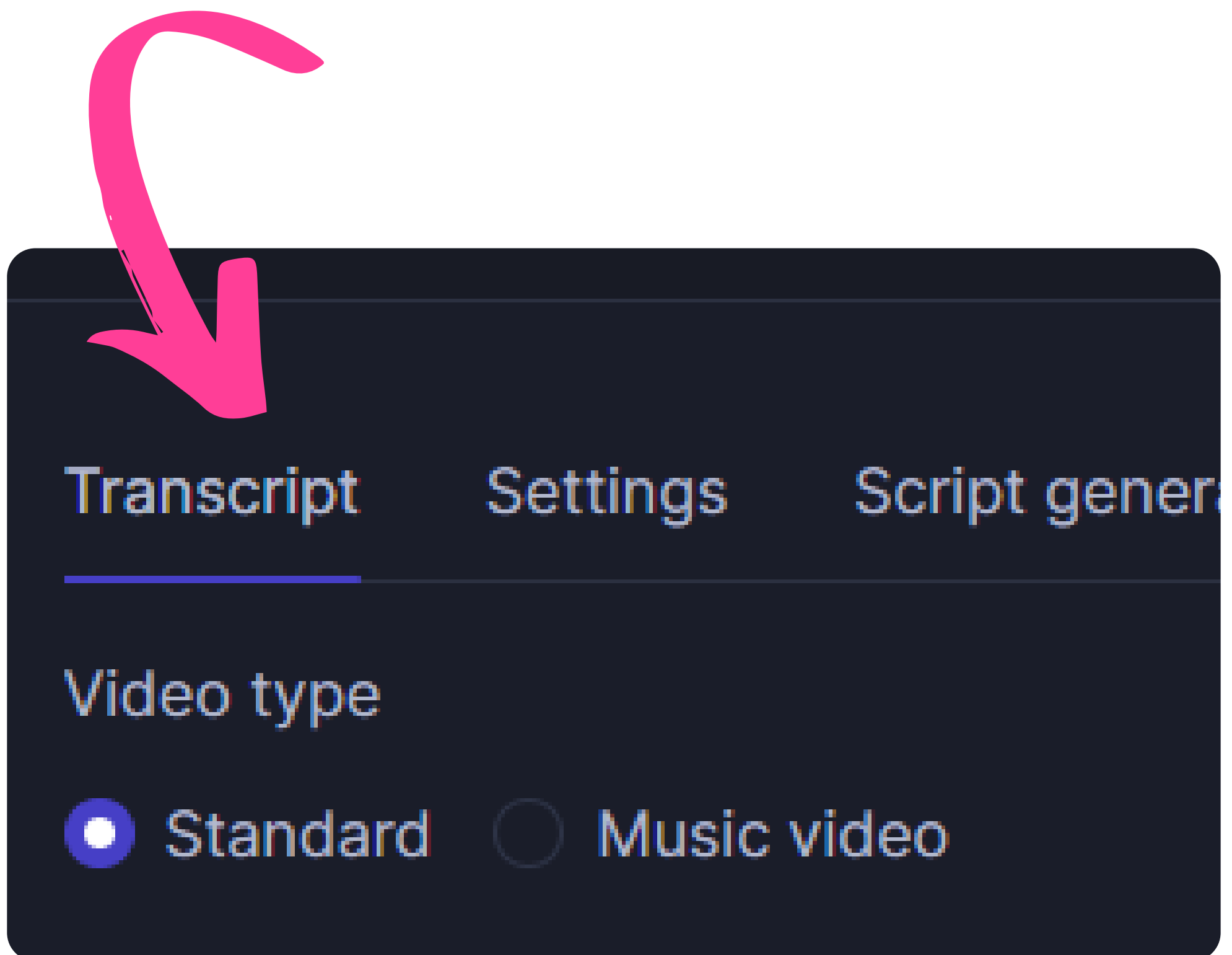

TRANSCRIPT

Here you can choose between **a standard video** and **a musical one**.



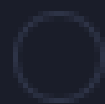

And if you decide to go for the **musical version** of the video, you only need two things:

- **Audio:** Here, you paste the file for your musical audio, which you can generate, for example, on SUNO.AI.

- **Song lyrics:** Here, you paste the lyrics of your song (you can copy them from SUNO.AI) so that VSUB can generate subtitles based on them.

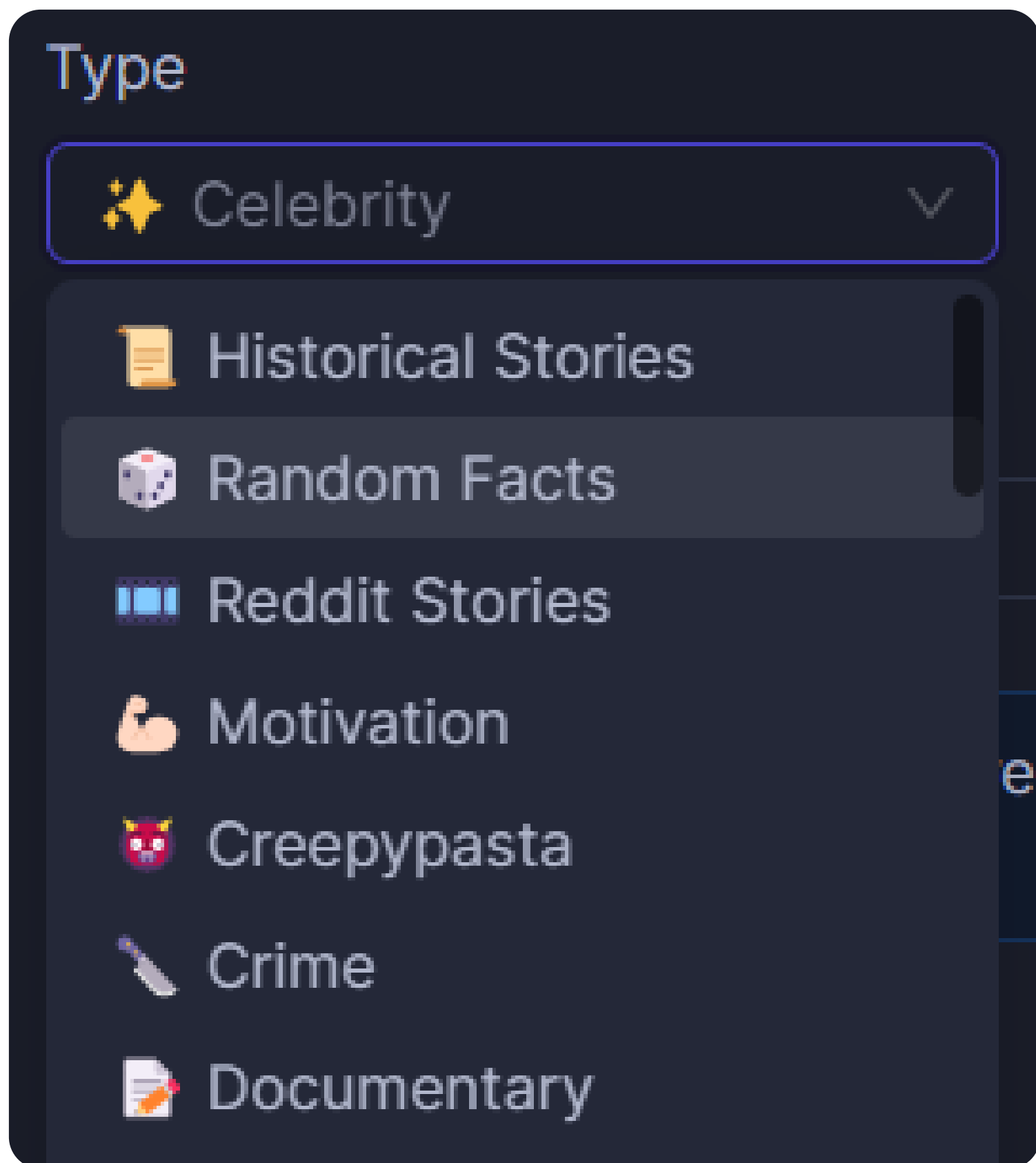

However, before you proceed to generate the script, you need to fill in two things: Type & Reference Video.

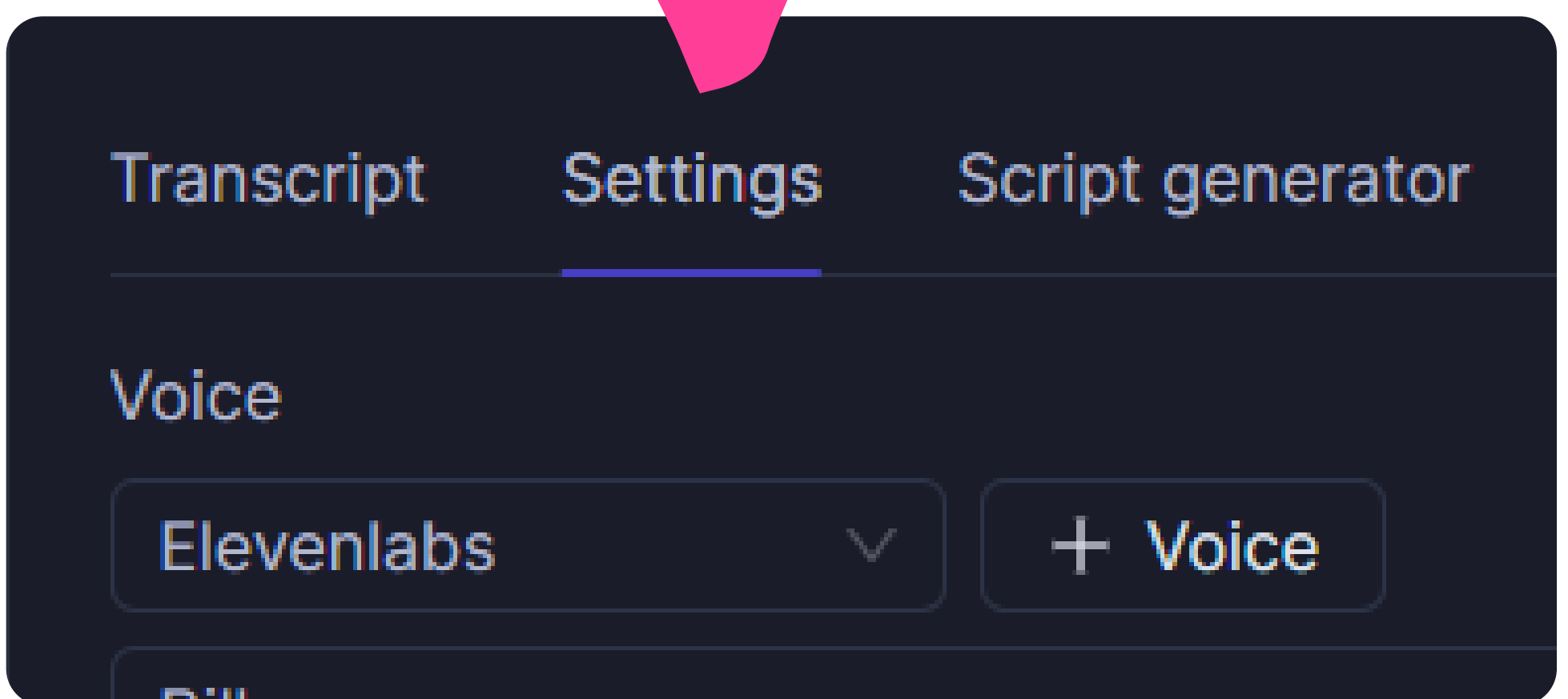

In the **Settings** tab, located between "Transcript" and "Script Generator," we choose the voice that will read the script (you don't change anything here if you previously selected a musical video).

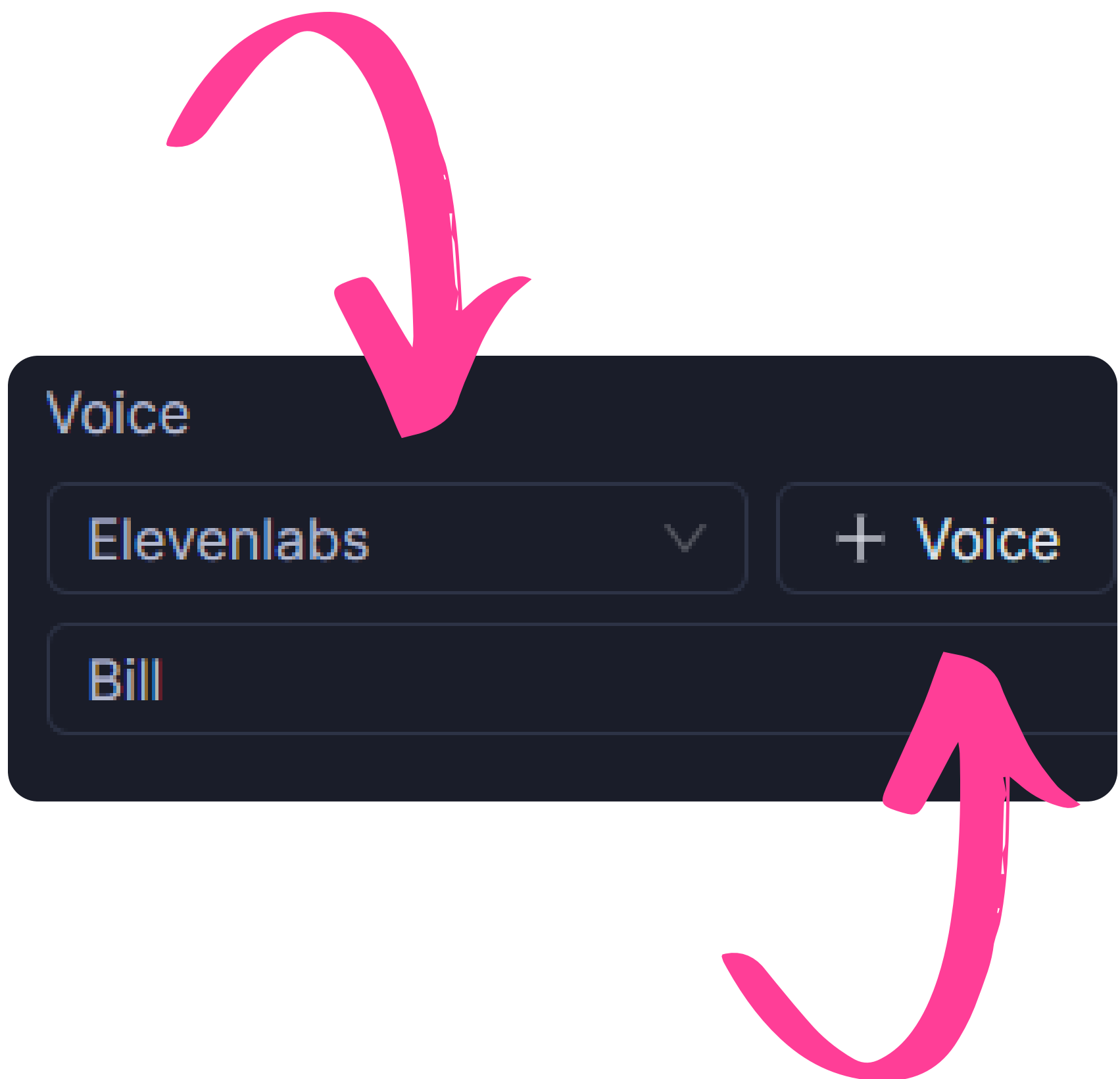
Next, we will describe the functions in the Settings tab in detail.

In the "**Voice**" section, you choose the voice that will read your script.

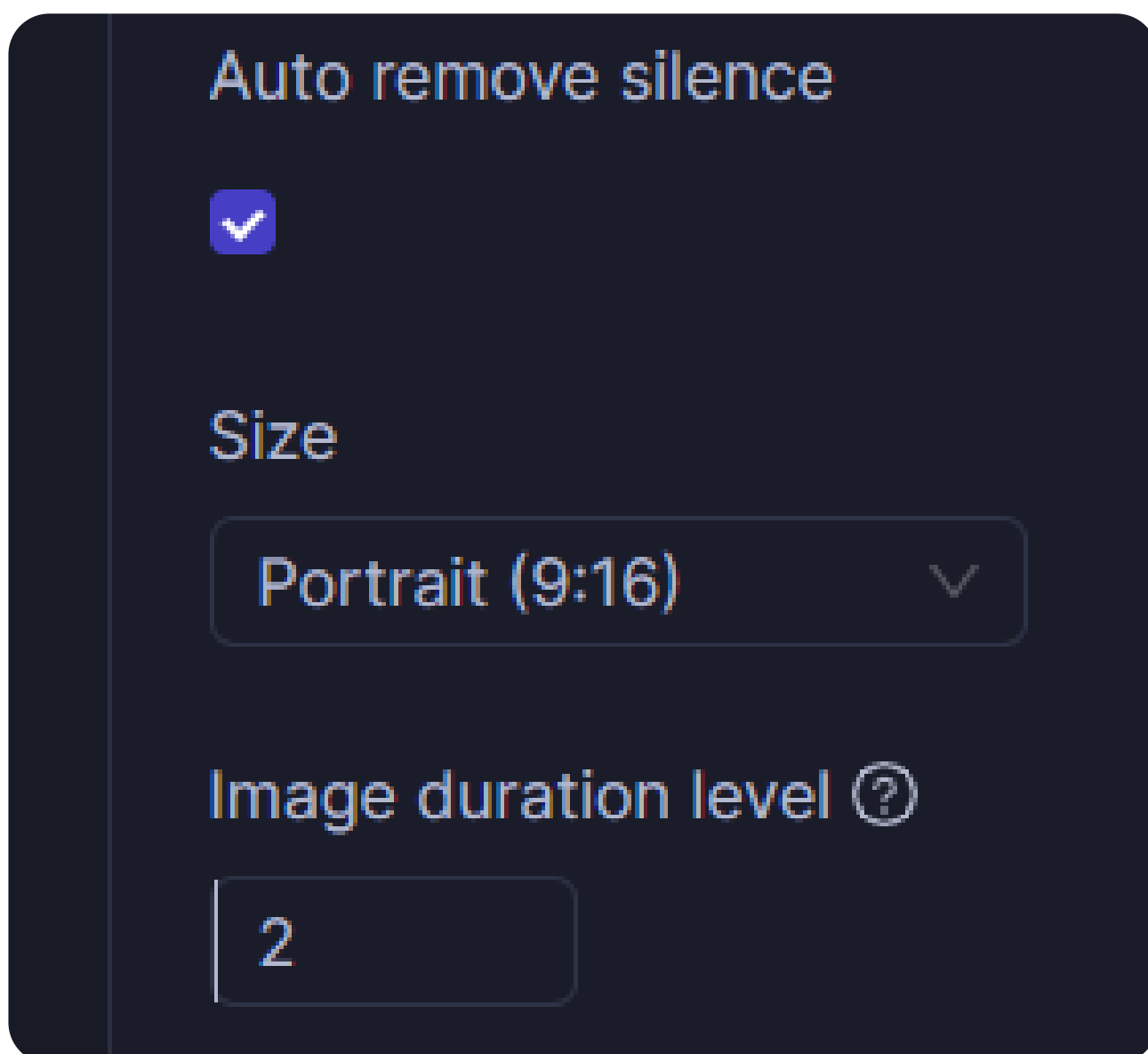


And if you want to add a voice from Elevenlabs that is not on this list, click on "**+Voice**" and paste the link from the Elevenlabs library.

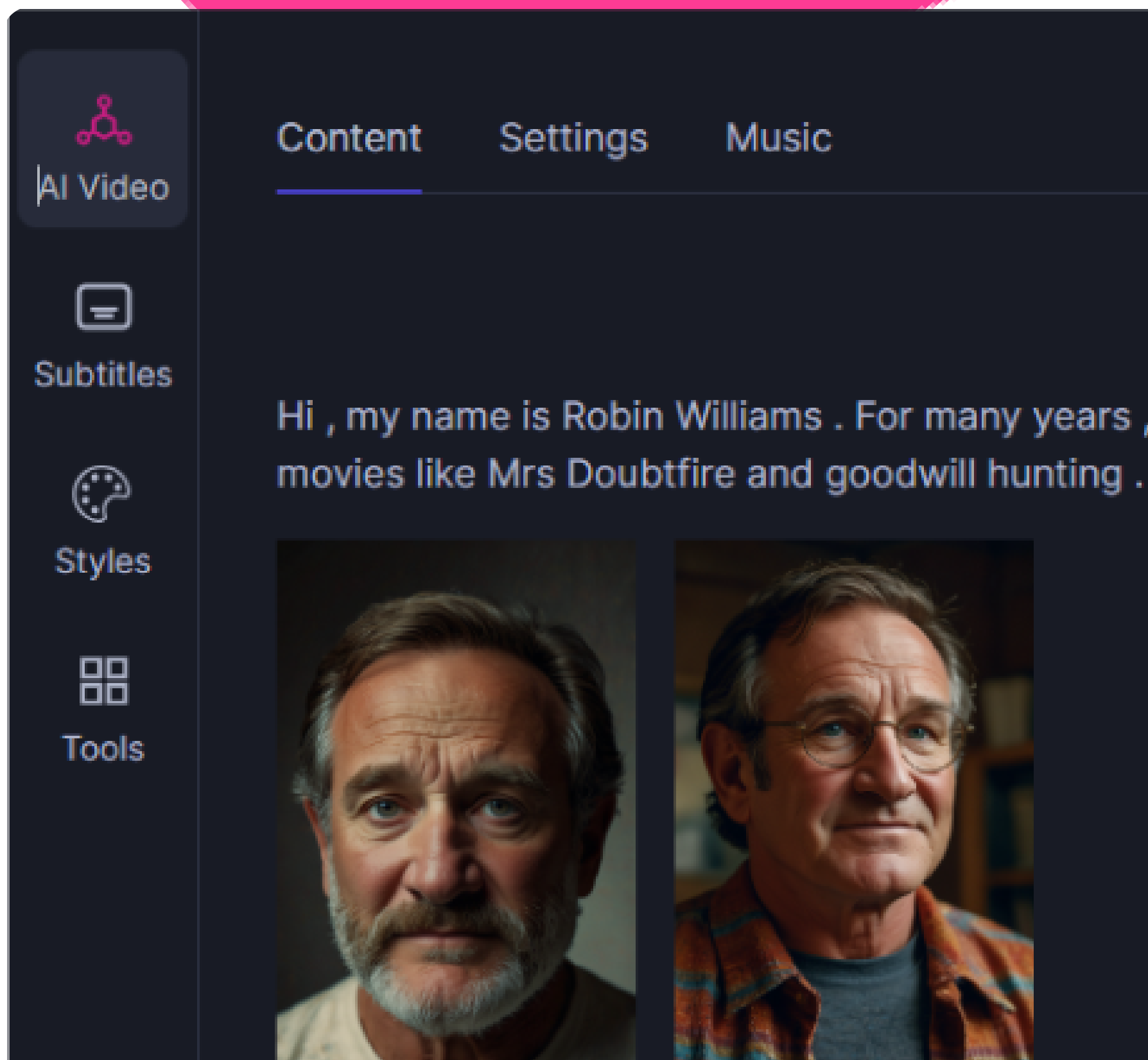
Below, we have the **"Auto-Remove Silence"** option, which removes silent moments in the generated voice. (I recommend selecting this option).

"Size" refers to the dimensions of our video (we can choose between portrait [TikTok] and landscape [YouTube longform]).

"Image Duration Level" specifies the number of seconds per generated image. The lower the level, the faster the images will change. Level 1 is about 3 seconds per image, while level 3 is about 9 seconds per image.

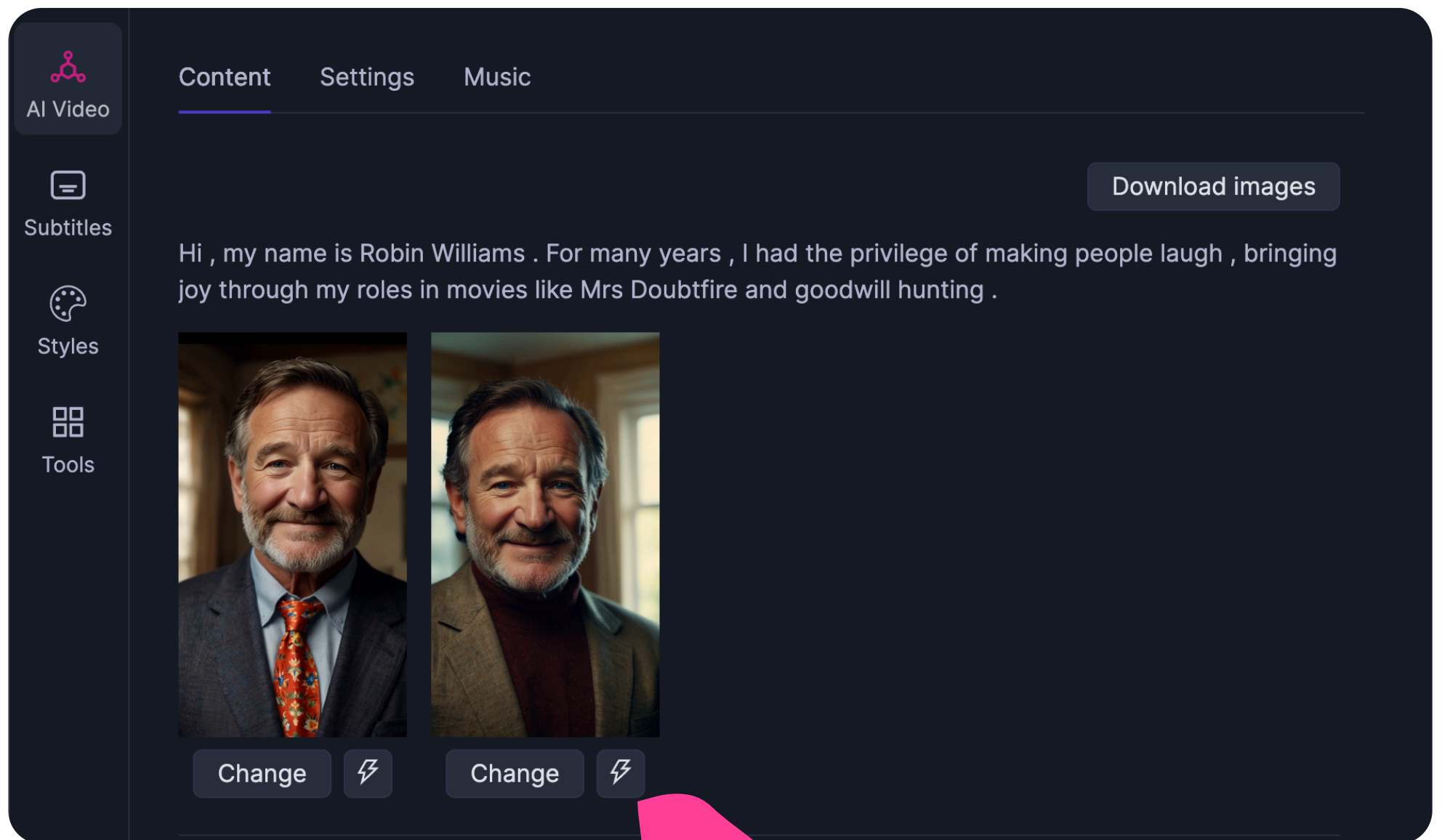

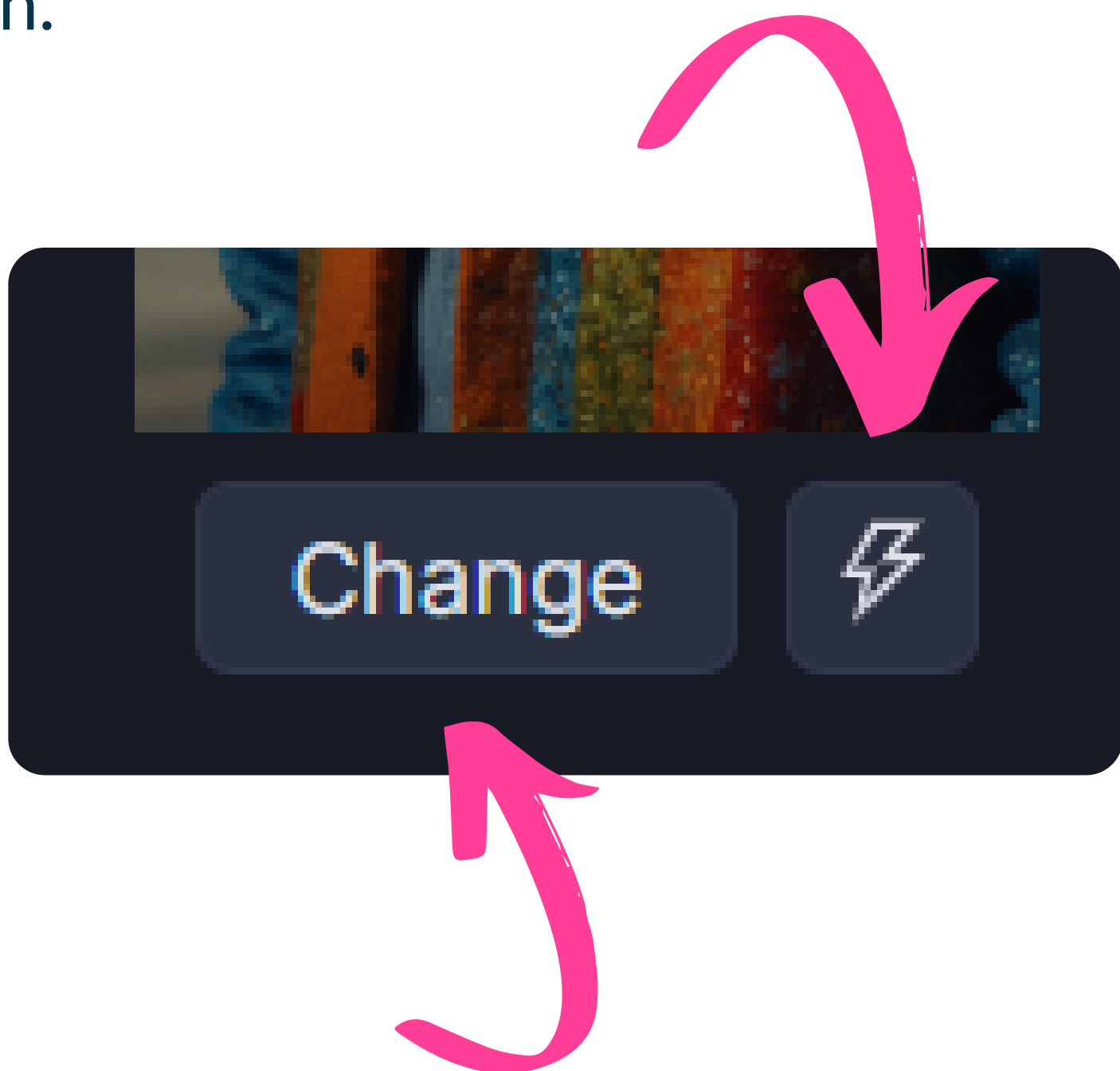
In the "**Content**" tab, you will see the images generated for you by the AI. In this section, we have three options that we can use.

The first two options are located just below each generated image

This button allows you to **regenerate your image**. After clicking on it, you will see the prompt used to create the image, and you can edit it yourself before generating it again.

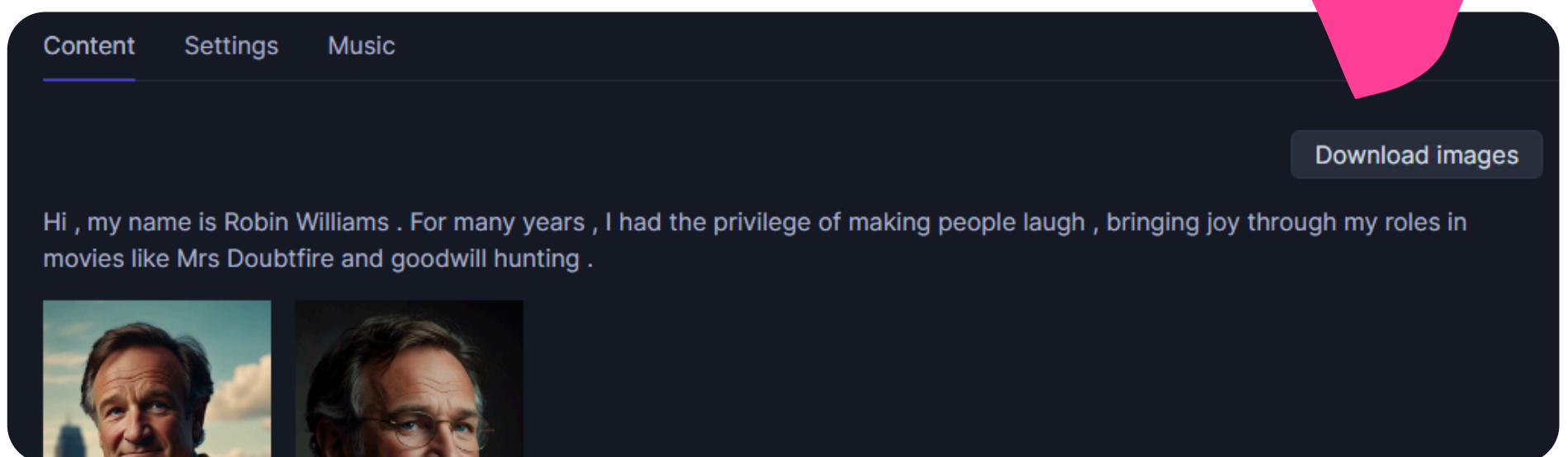
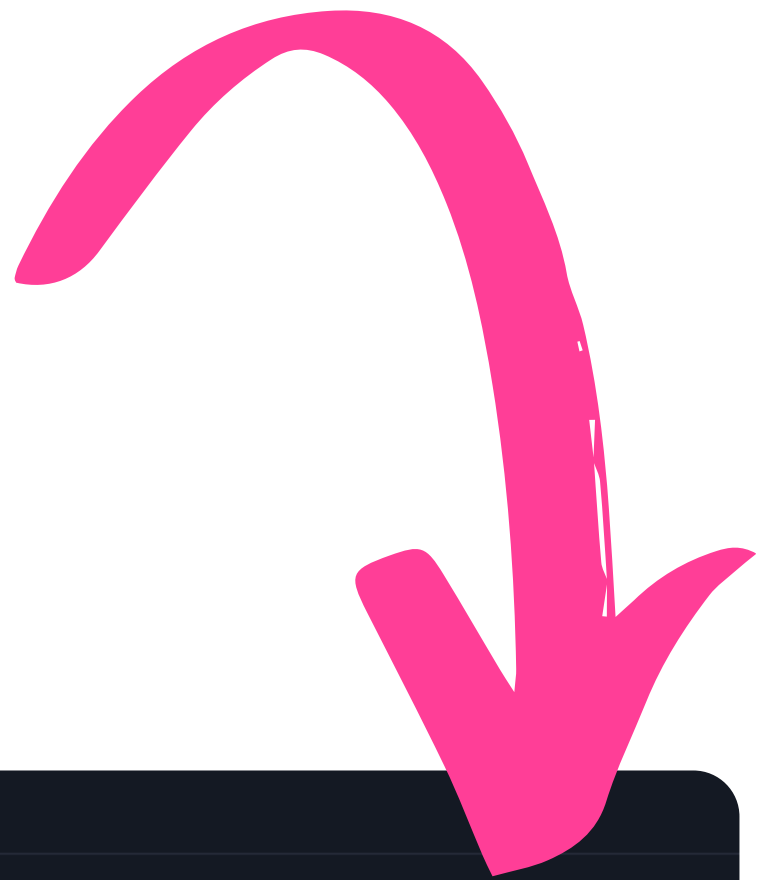


"**Change**" allows you to upload your own photo to replace the one generated by the AI.

The "**Download images**" option downloads all the generated images to your computer.

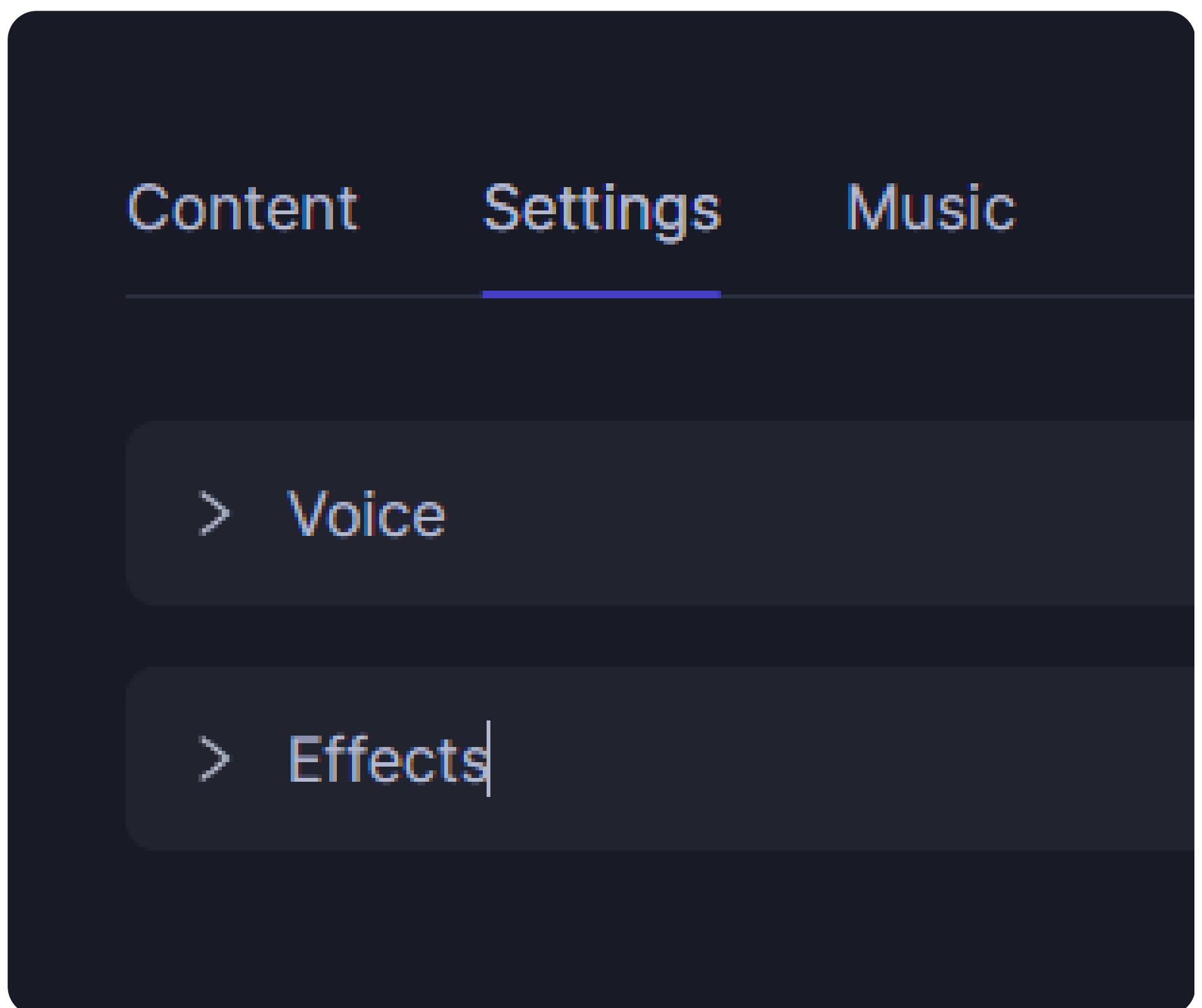


Now let's move to the "**Settings**" tab.

In the "**Settings**" tab, we have two options: Voice and Effects.



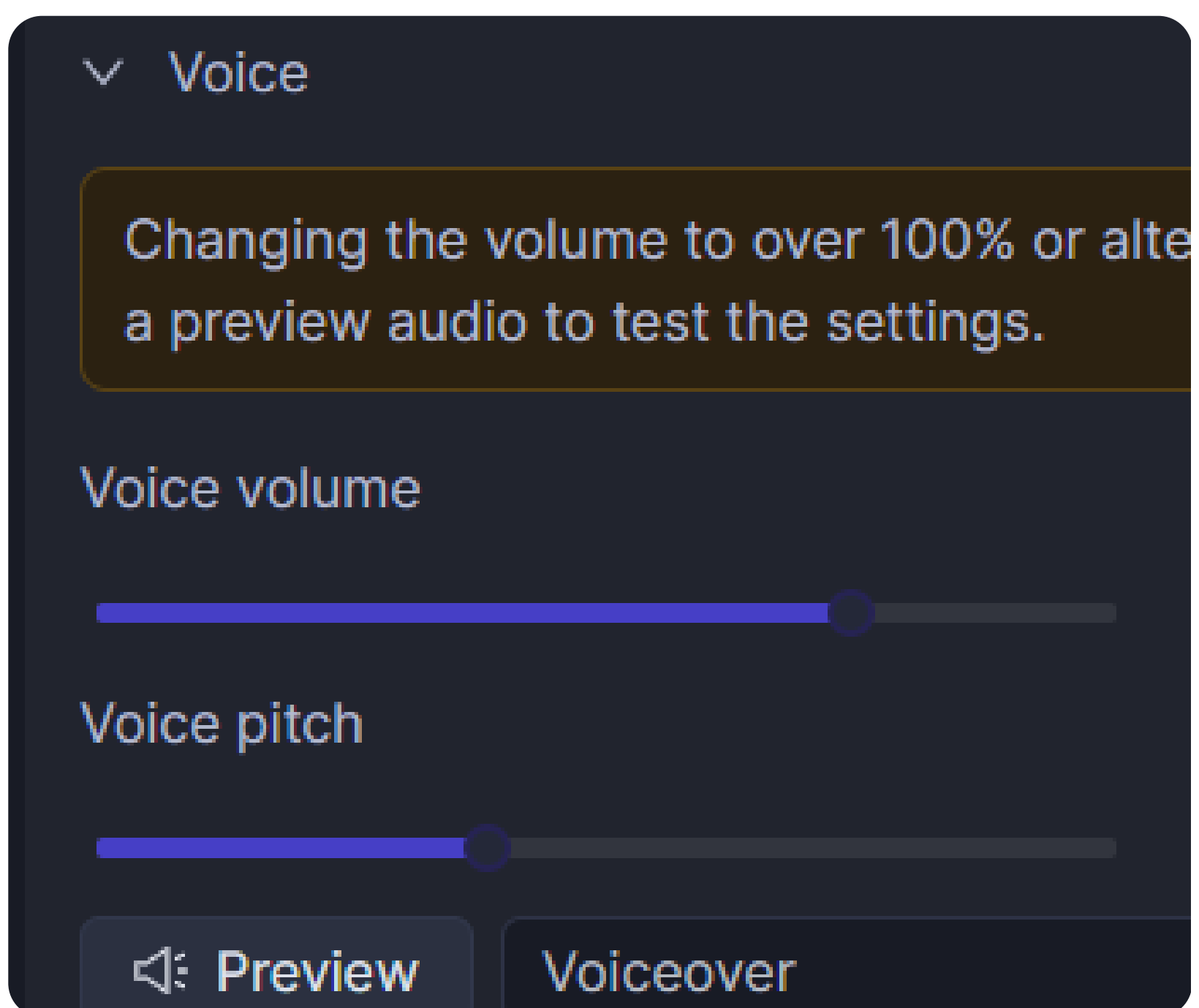

In the "**Voice**" tab, we also have two options:

- "**Voice Volume**," where we can increase or decrease the volume of our voiceover using a slider.
- "**Voice Pitch**," where we can raise or lower the pitch of the voice using a slider.

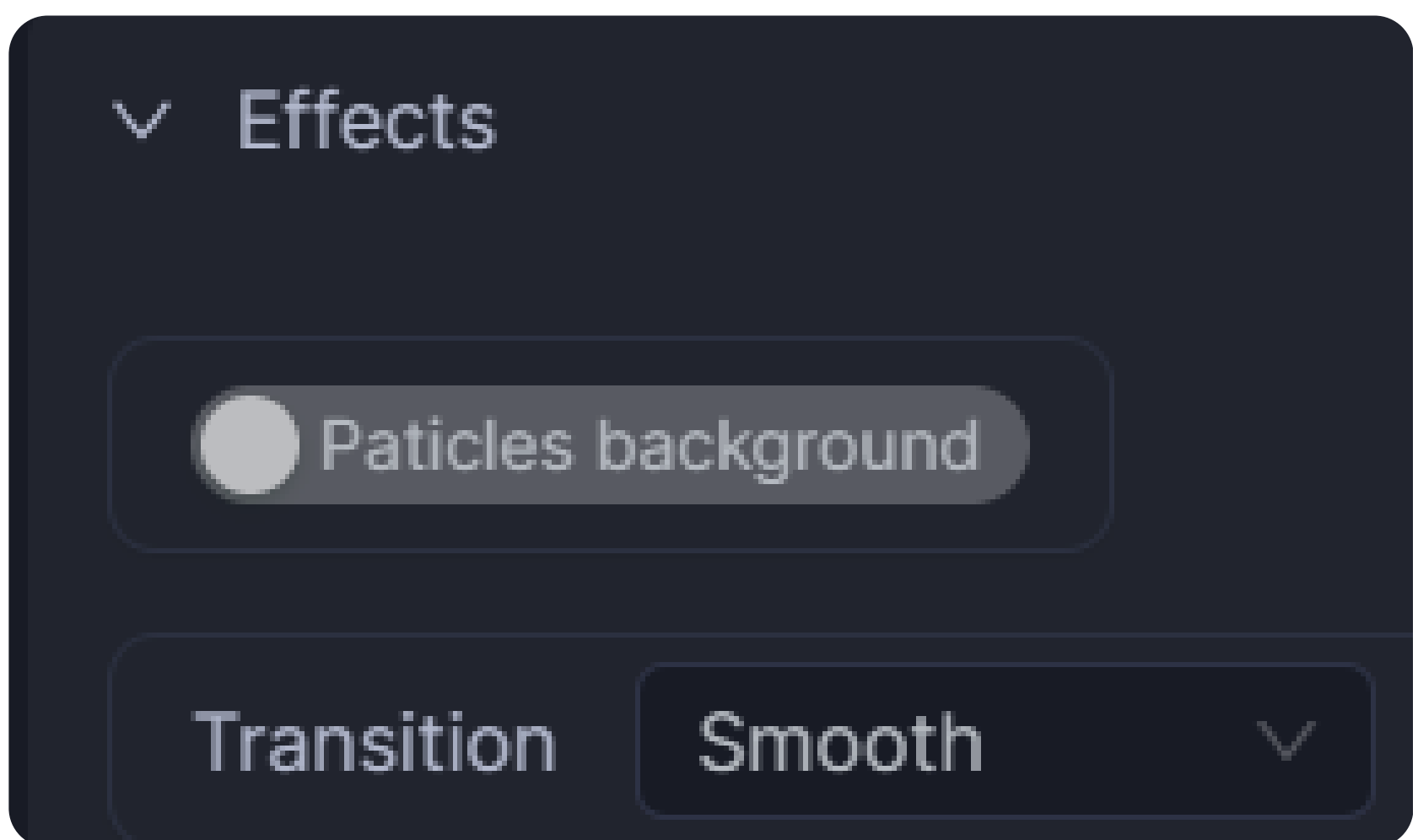
The "**Preview**" option allows us to hear the changes we have made

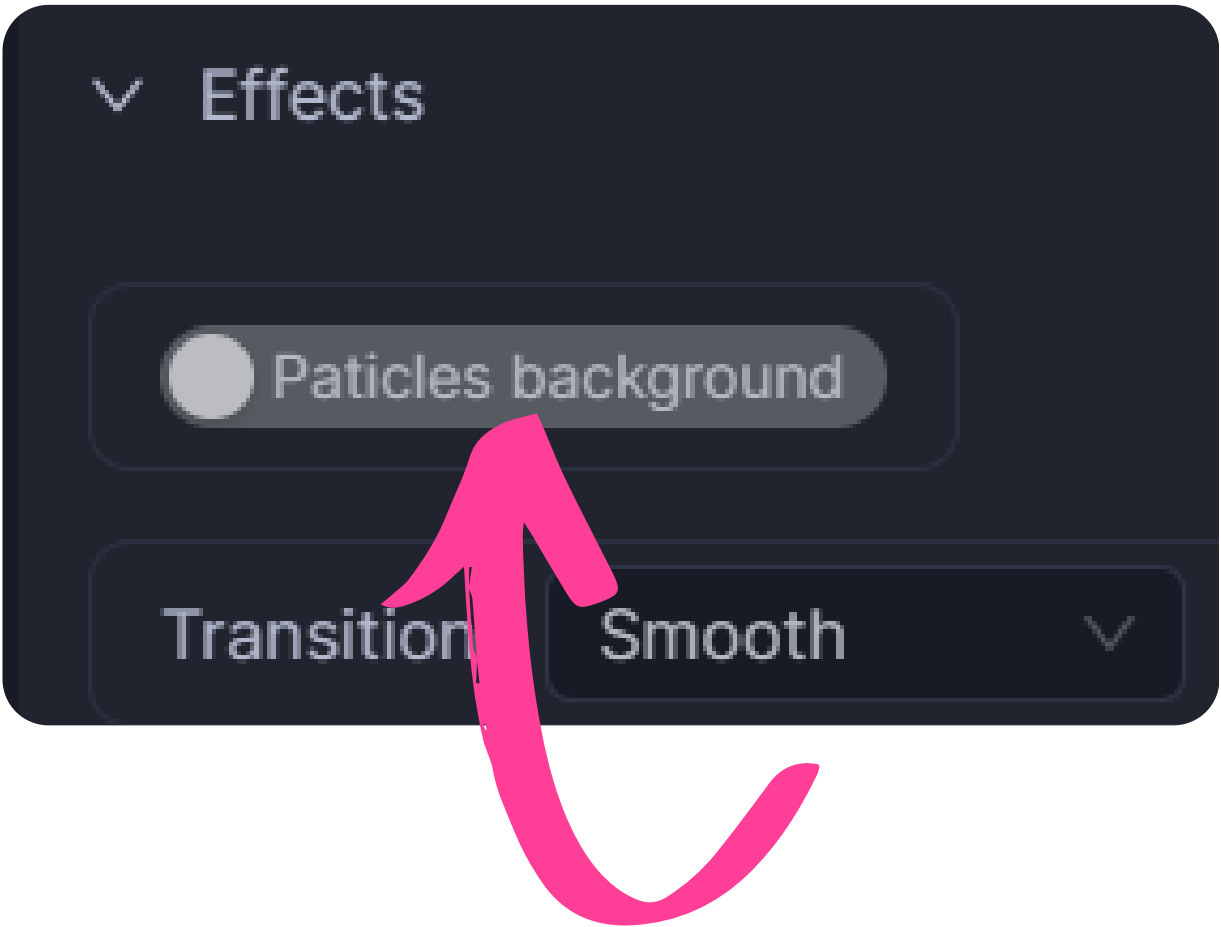
In the **"Effects"** tab, you can change the background effect and the way the images scroll.



The **"Transition"** option allows you to choose between "Smooth" and "Strong swipe." The "Particles background" effect is demonstrated on the next page.

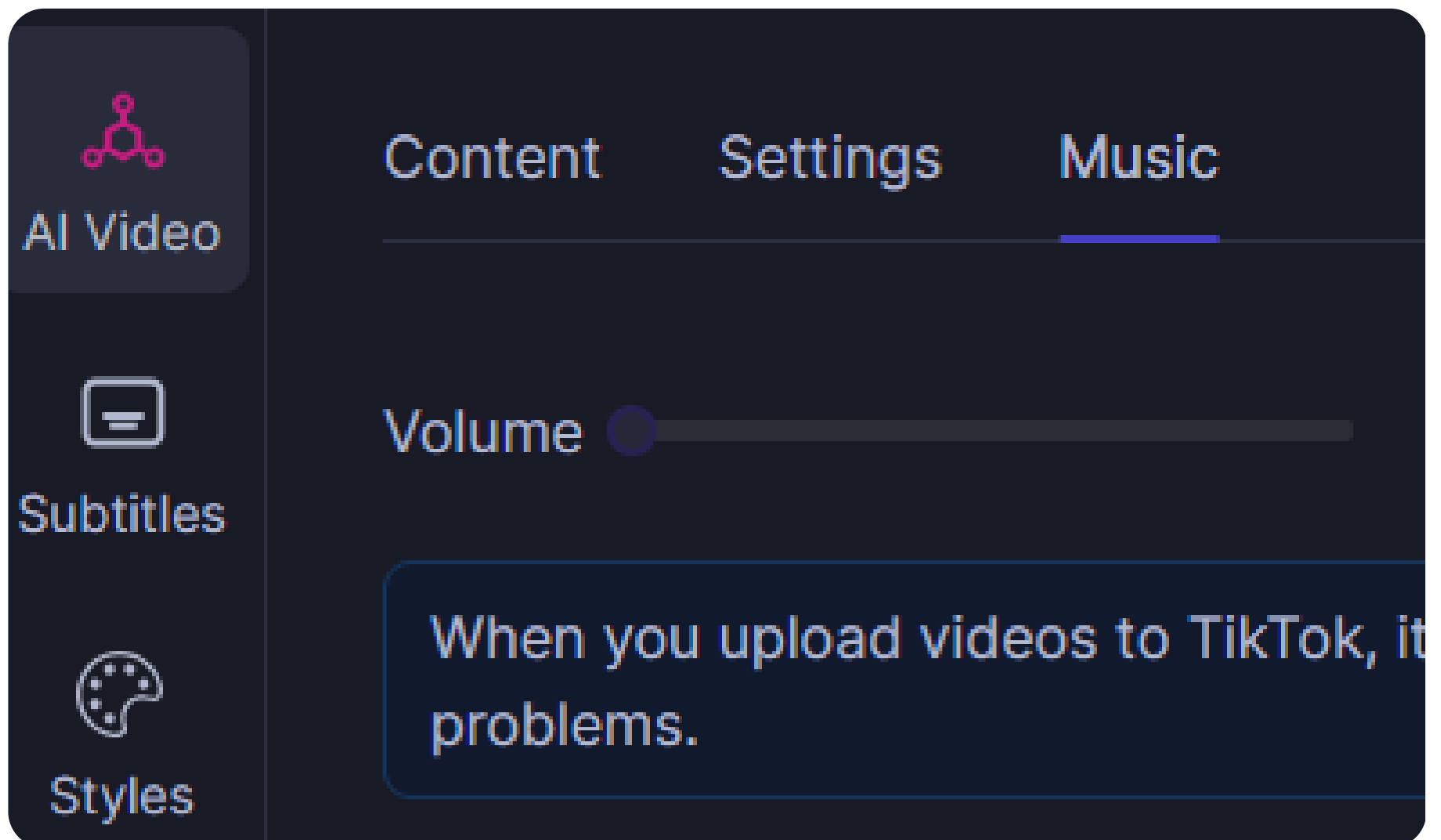

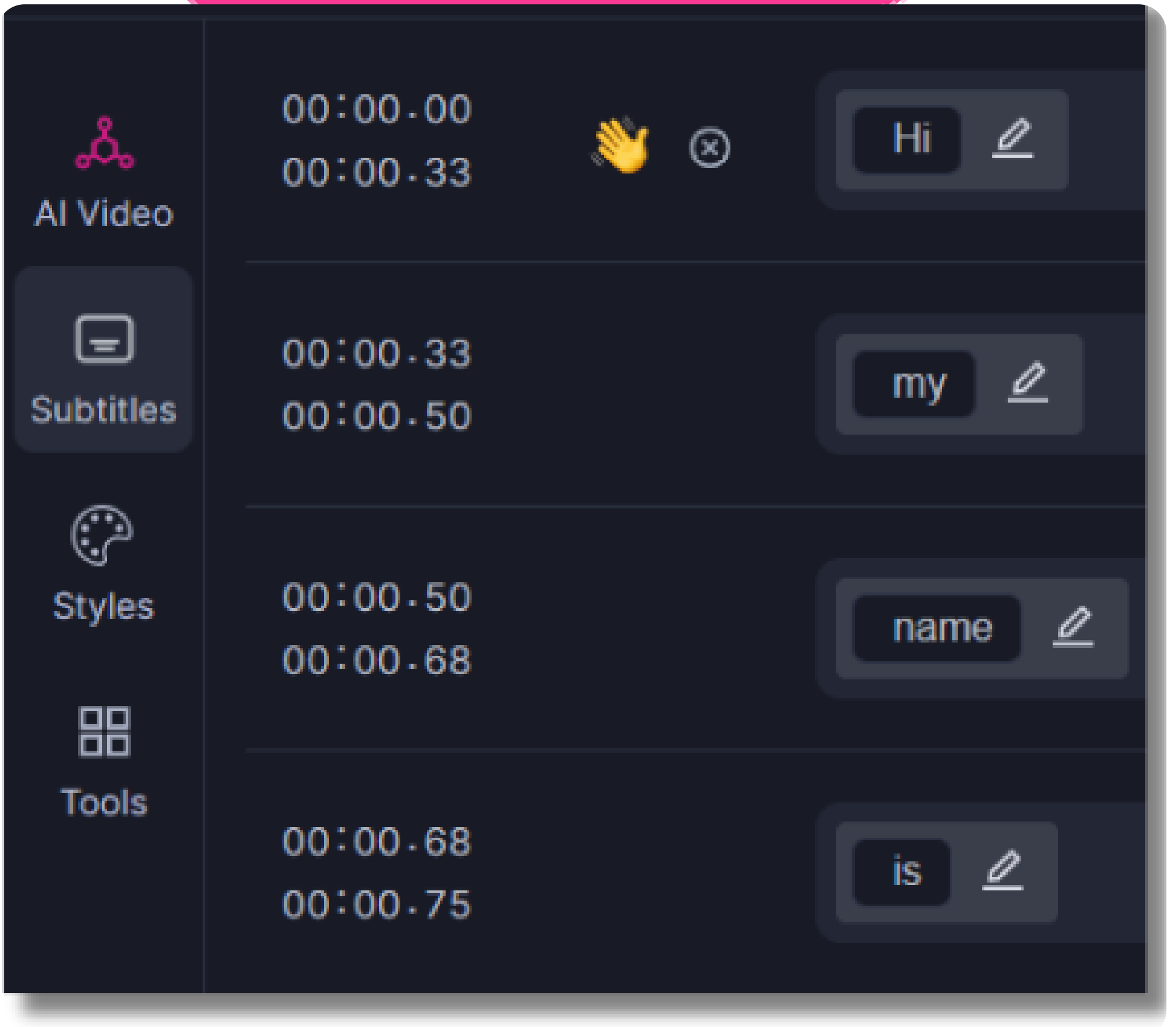

"**Music**" is the last tab in the "AI Video" section.

Here, you can add background music to your video; however, we recommend adding music directly on TikTok/YouTube.



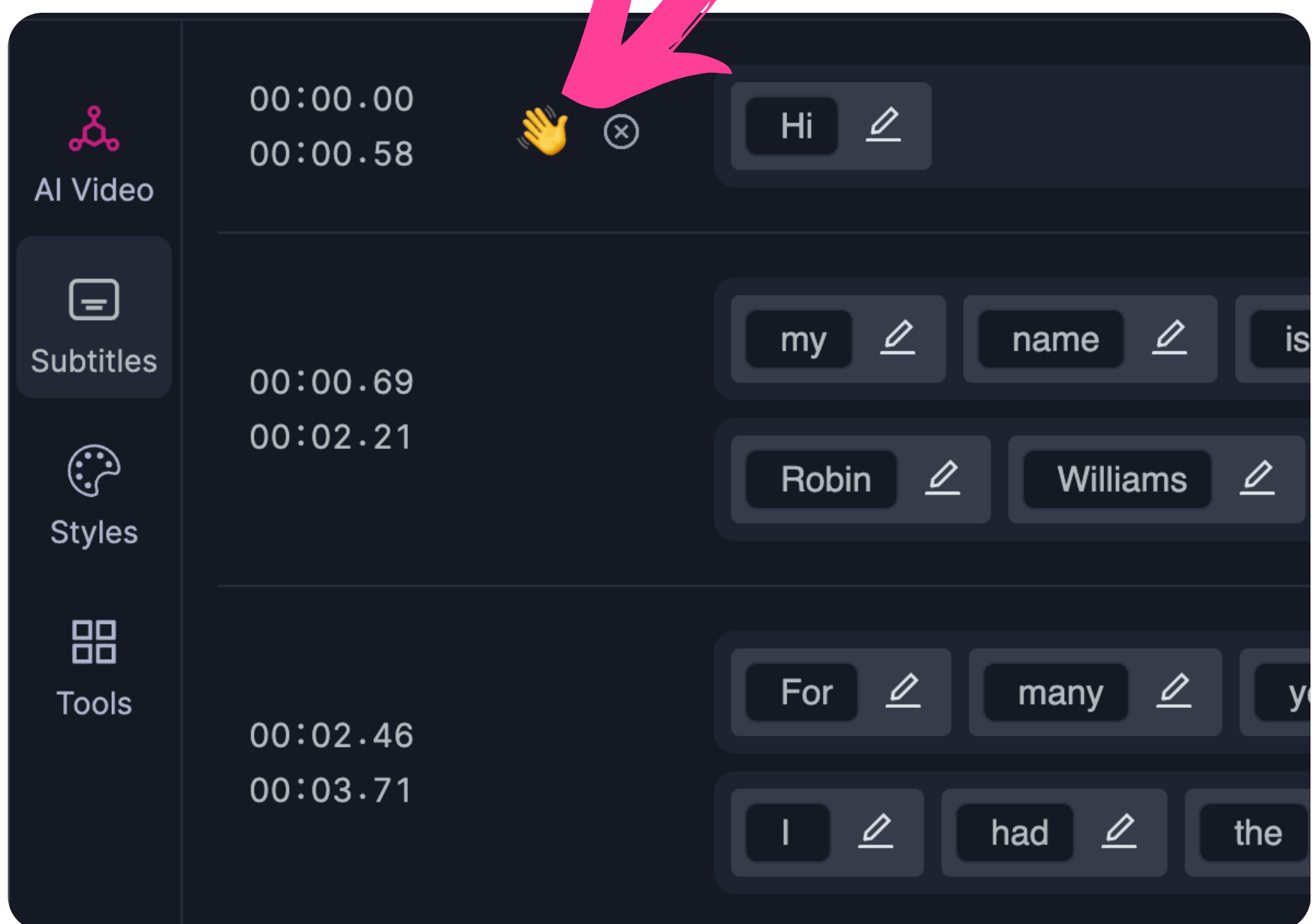

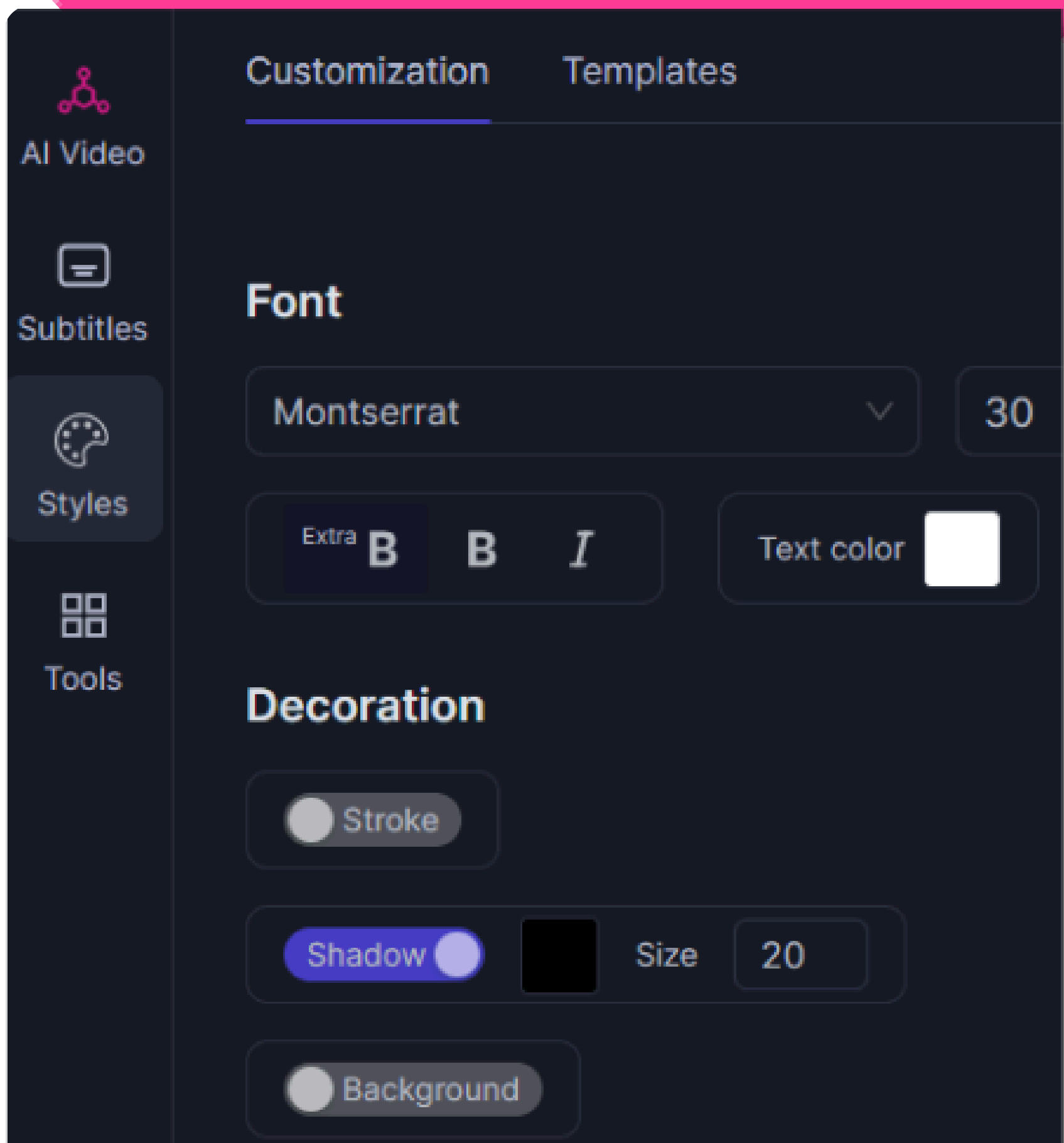

SUBTITLES

In the "**Subtitles**" tab, you can edit the generated text and add emojis to it. You don't edit the subtitle style here; that is done in the next tab.

After clicking here, you can choose emojis from the list, upload custom ones, or click "suggest" to automatically generate emojis that match the text.

In the **"Styles"** category, you can choose from existing templates and then configure the appearance of your subtitles.

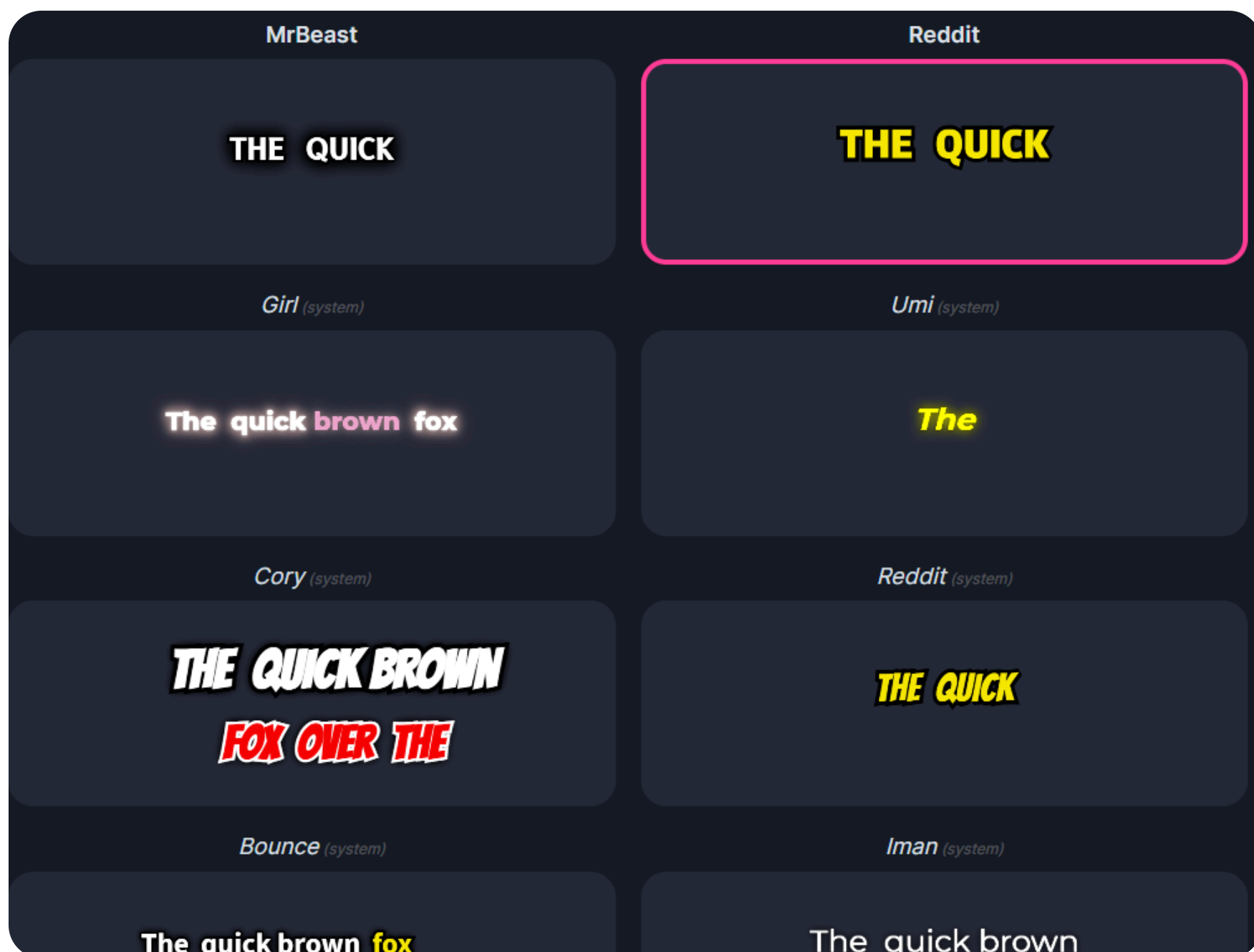

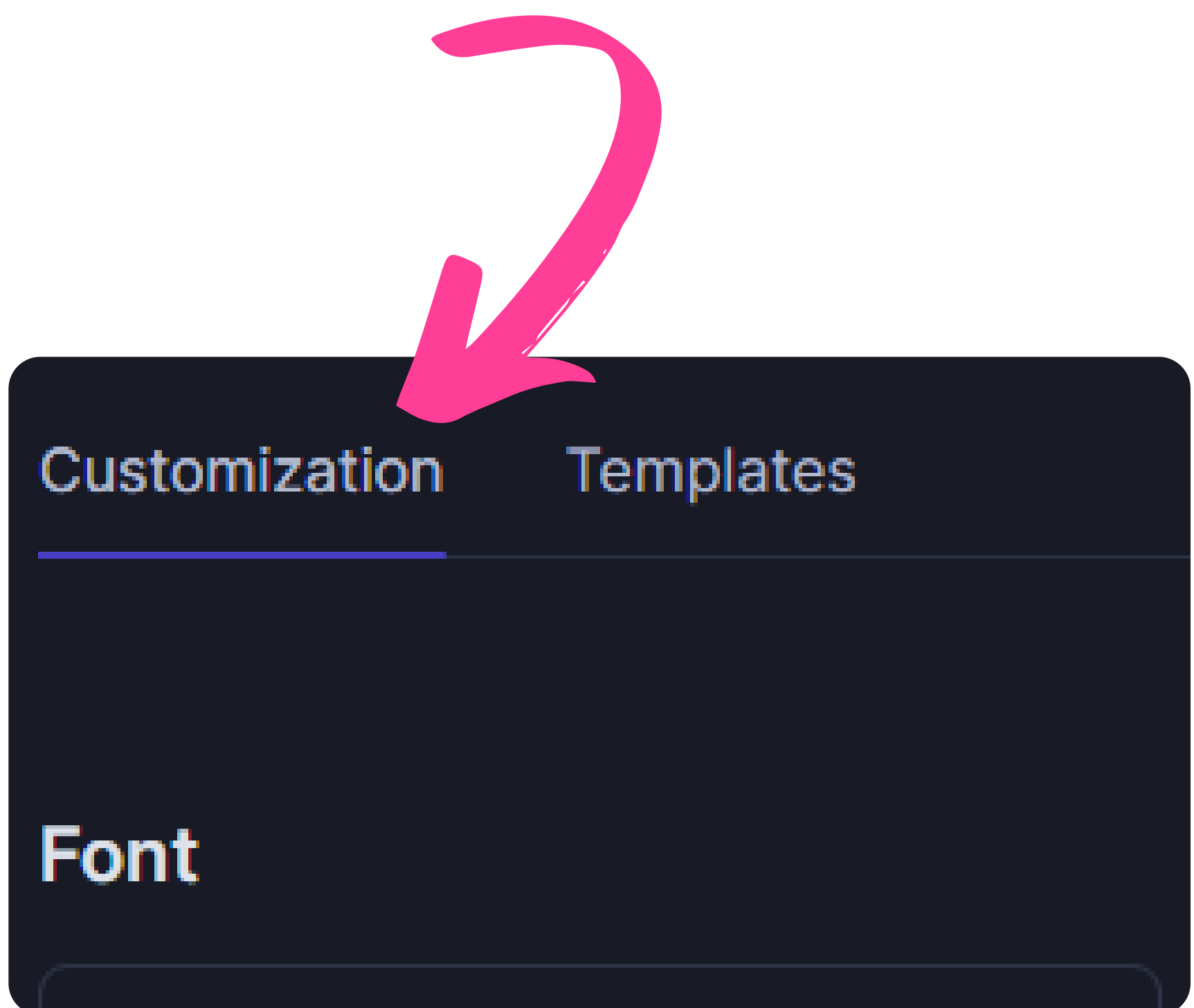
In "**Templates**," you have a choice of 14 different text templates. After clicking on a specific template, you will see how it looks on the right side in the "Preview."

Remember: Changing the template will force regenerate subtitles, remove all emojis, and custom settings on subtitle lines.

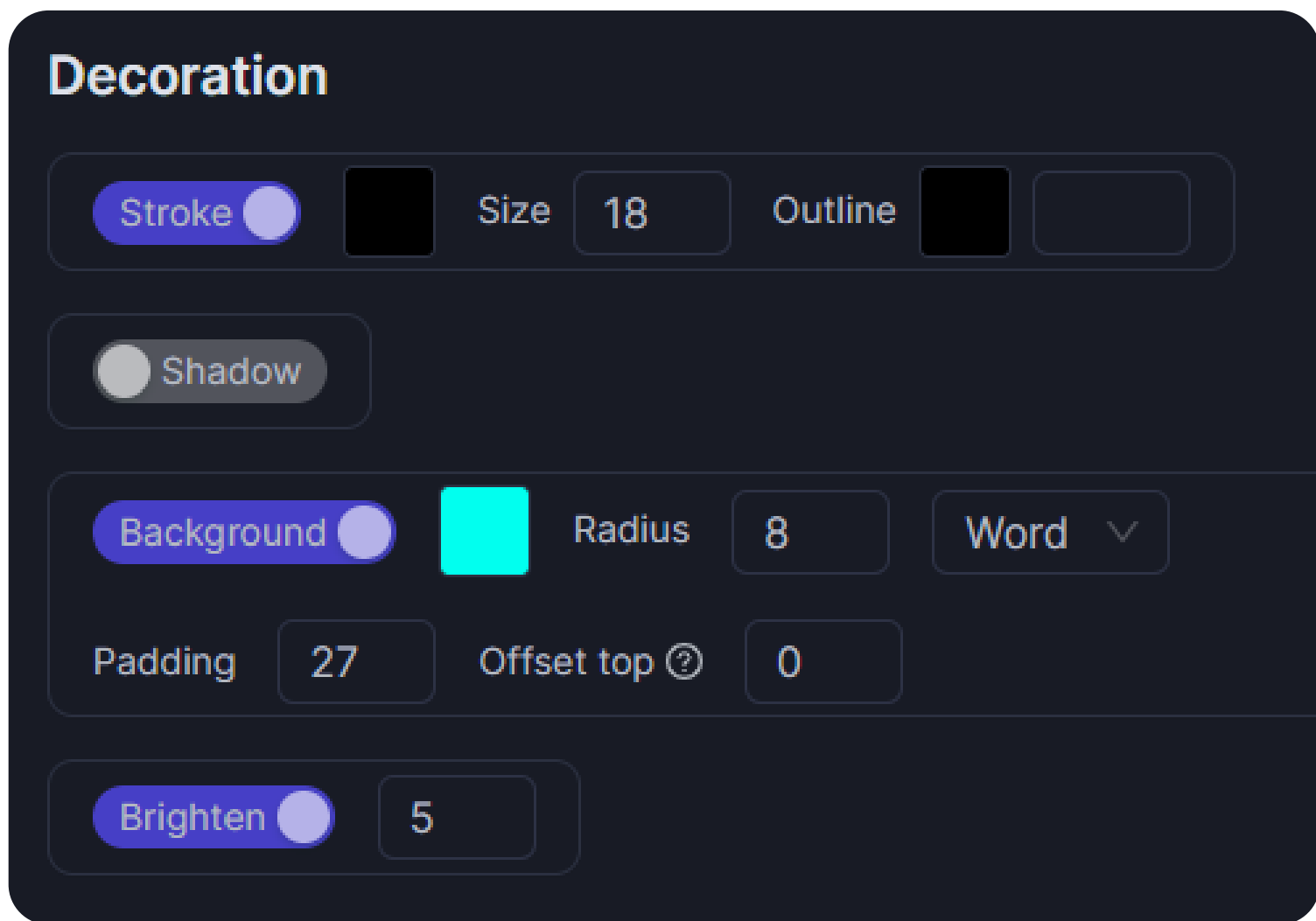

In "**Font**," we have the basics: we choose the text font, its size, whether it should be uppercase, its color, and text alignment.

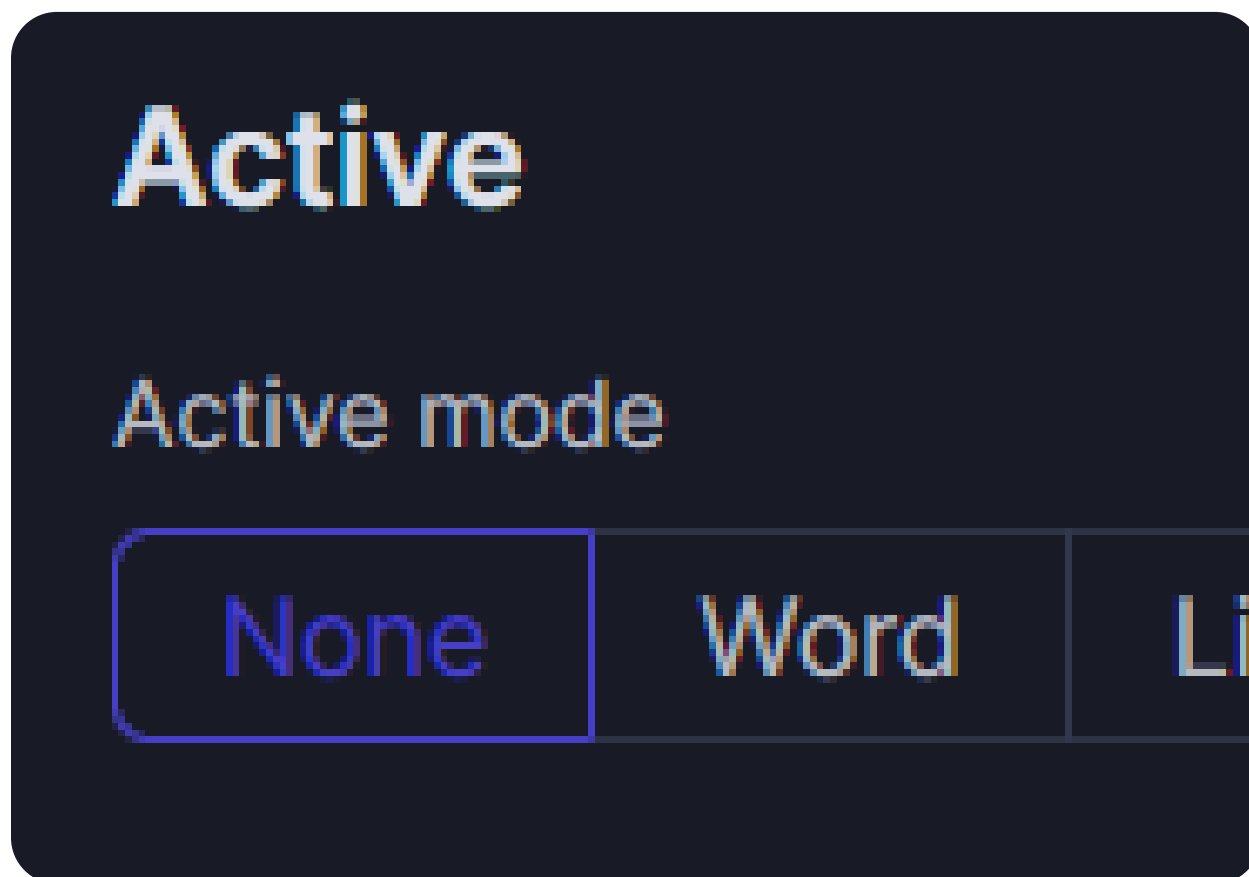
- Stroke:** A toggle switch (checked), a color picker (black), a 'Size' input (18), and an 'Outline' section with a color picker (black) and a width input (empty).

In "**Decoration**," we have four text effects to set up:

- **Stroke:** we choose whether we want it at all, then its color, size, and additionally, we can also select an outline and its color.
- **Shadow:** similarly, we choose whether we want it, and then select its color and size.
- **Background:** then we choose whether we want a background color for our subtitles. If so, we set its color, area (whether it should cover only one word or all displayed words), size, and positioning.
- **Brighten:** we decide whether we want to brighten our text, and if so, we choose the intensity.

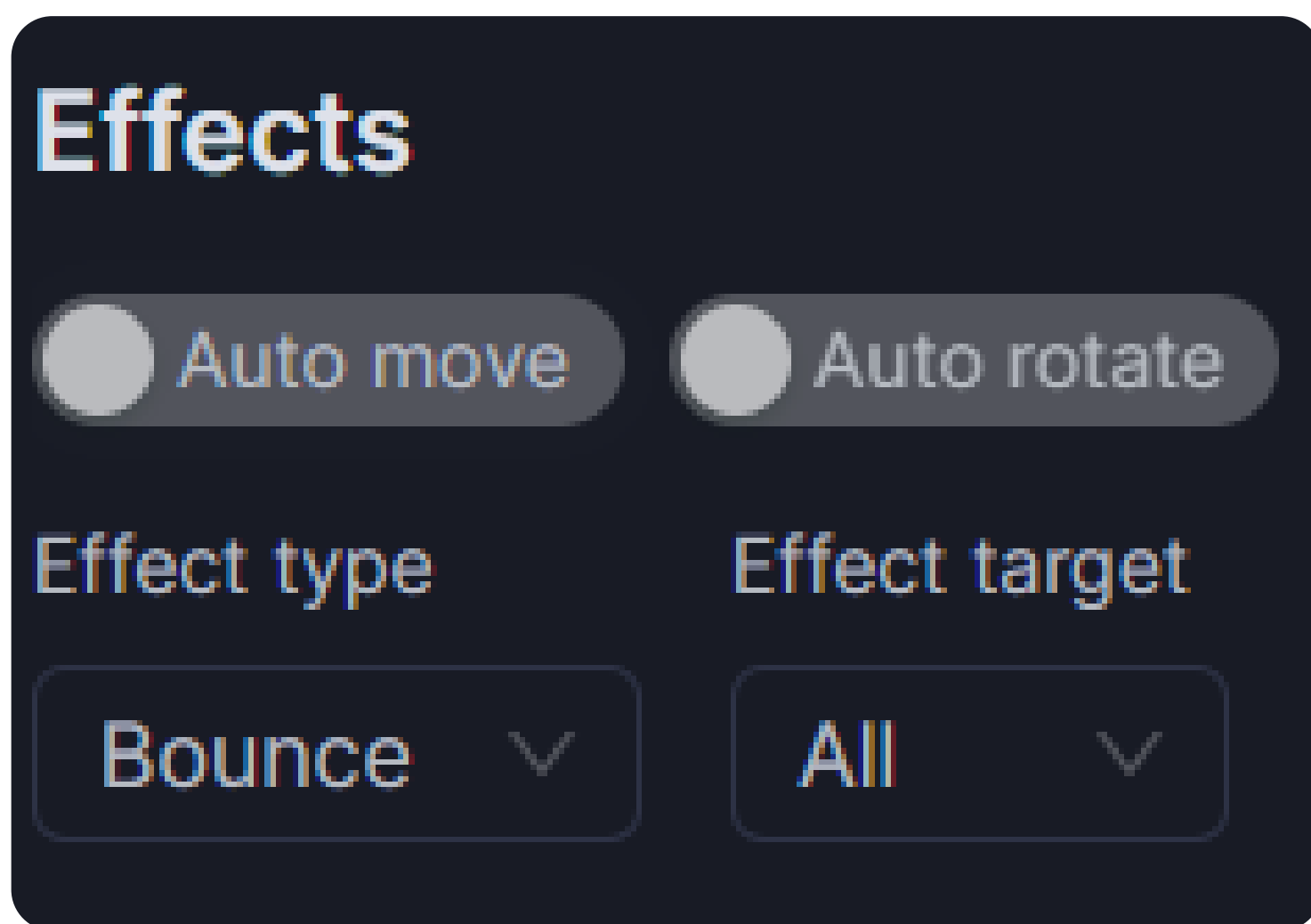
In "**Active**" you change the settings exclusively for the active word, i.e., the word currently being spoken by the narrator. You can change its color, size, and stroke.



And in "**Emoji**" you can change the position where the emojis appear and their size.

CUSTOMIZATION

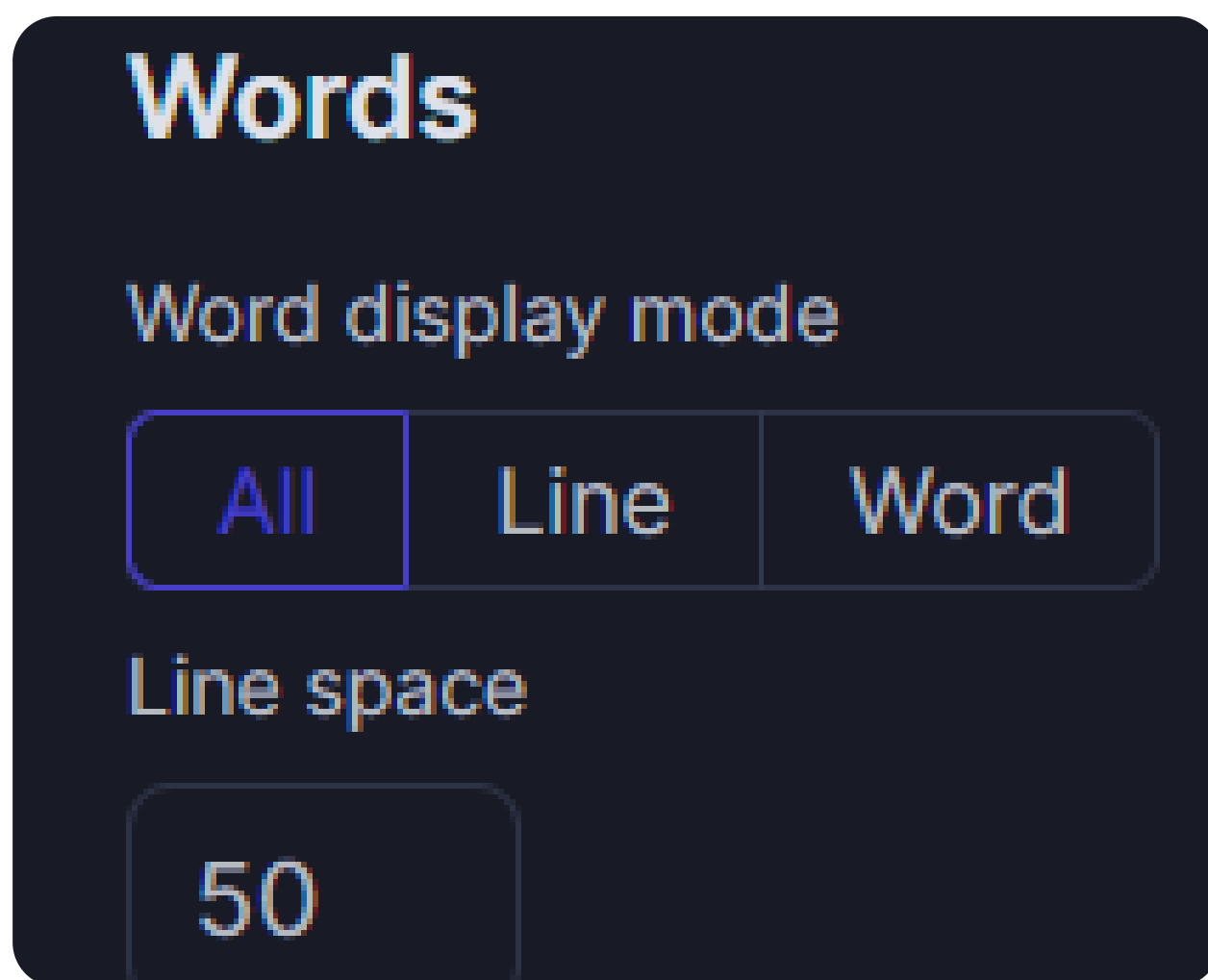


In **"Effects"** you can apply effects to your subtitles:

- **"Auto Move"** enables movement for your subtitles.
- **"Auto Rotate"** tilts your subtitles in different directions.
- In **"Effect Type"** you choose one of three options that you like the most (remember, you can preview everything immediately on the right in the Preview).
- In **"Effect Target"** you select whether you want to apply the effect to a specific word or the entire line.

CUSTOMIZATION



In "**Words**" you set how your subtitles will appear: whether all at once (*All*), line by line (*Line*), or word by word (*Word*). The "**Line Space**" option allows us to adjust the spacing between lines of text.



In "**Position**" you simply position your subtitles.

CUSTOMIZATION

In "**Limit**" you set the maximum number of words per line and the maximum number of lines to be displayed.

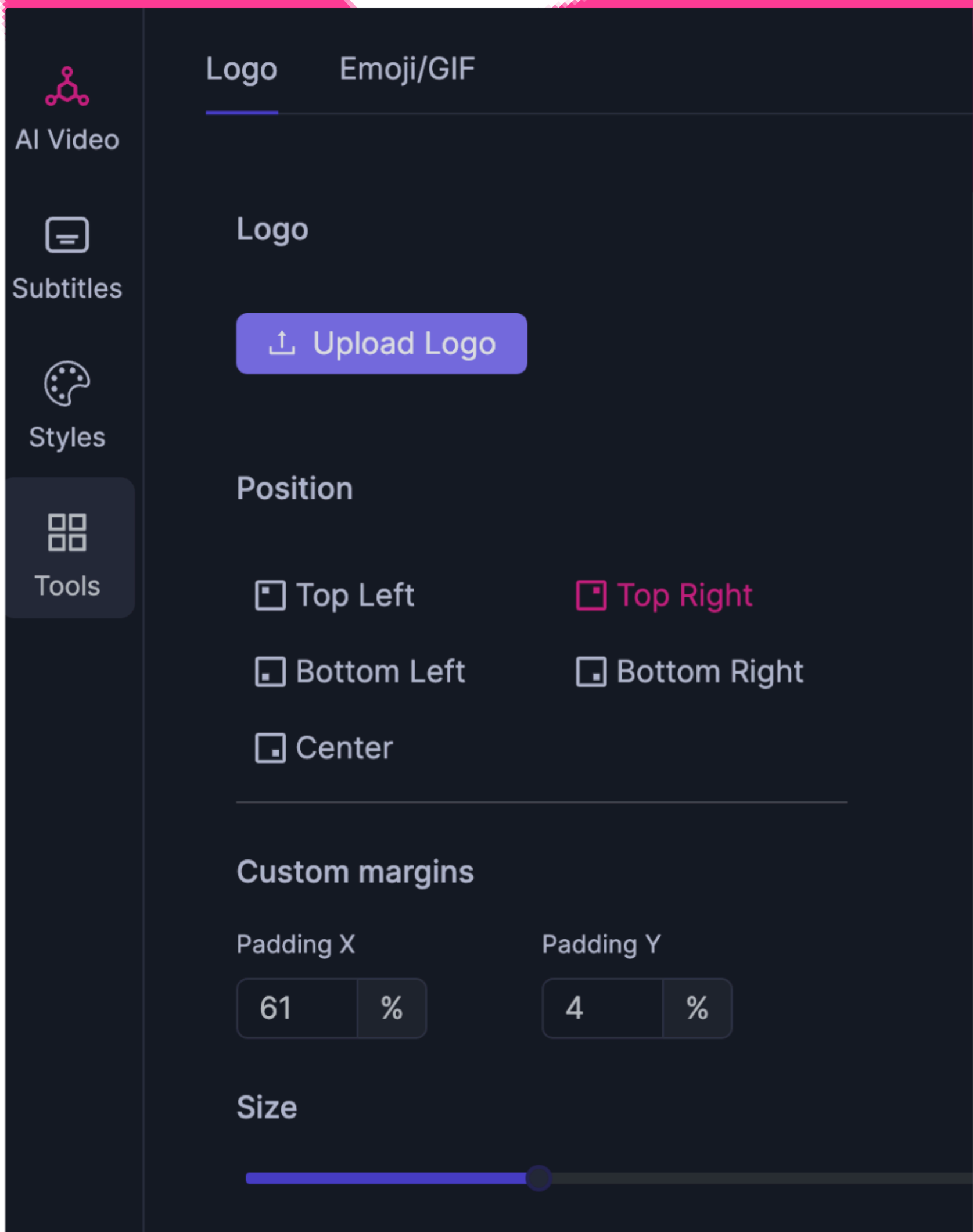

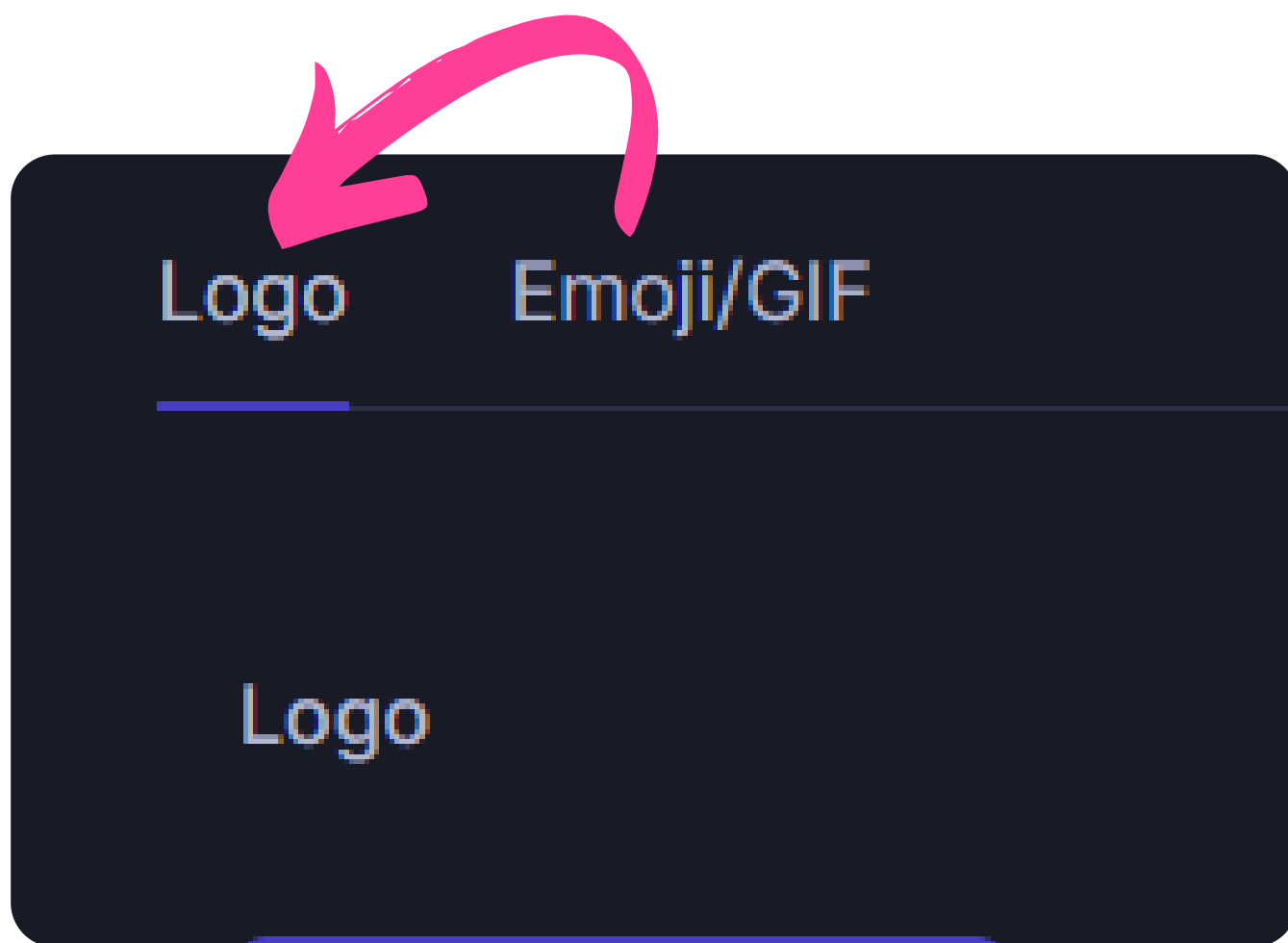

TOOLS

In the last tab, "**Tools**", you can upload your logo (e.g., as a watermark) and adjust its size, position, and transparency.



Here, you can also **add custom emojis** and **generate automatic emojis** that match your text.
